Michael Milano and Family Class of 1971

In 1963, a group of men, led by Sonny Milano, helped start the

Downingtown Young Whippets football program. Sonny's son, Michael was on the very first 95 pound team, creating a lifelong love of the sport.

Mike continued playing football through Junior High and Downingtown High School, graduating in 1971. Mike joined the Army following graduation and was honorably discharged in 1973 at which time he began coaching the same youth football team that gave him his start.

A few years later, Mike became the first non-faculty football coach in the district serving as an assistant coach at the junior high and then as a varsity assistant. In 1988, while working full time as a Mailman, Mike enrolled at West Chester University majoring in physical education. In 1991, He began his teaching career at Garnet Valley and coached teams at Unionville and Penncrest High Schools, capturing a District 1 title at Unionville in 1993.

In 2003 Downingtown split. Mike was named the head coach of the very first Downingtown WEST Whippets. During his 21 years at WEST, Mike's teams won 5 Ches Mont Titles and made the District finals twice, finally capturing a coveted District 16A title in 2019.

Mike retired after the 2023 season with a career record of 211-131-1 enabling him to spend more time with his family; his wife Dodie, daughters Nikki and Dana and his two grandchildren, Natalie and Daniel. He credits them for their unwavering support through his 31 years as a head coach. Mike's dedication to his Alma Mater, his students, his players and to our football program proves that Once a Whippet, always a Whippet! Congratulations, Michael Milano.
